PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

DEAR HASL MEMBERS:

At the Oct. 10th business meeting, you will be asked to vote on a change in the by-laws of the organization, Article III, section 4. It presently reads, in part:

Section 4. Annual dues Annual dues for regular members shall be one dollar; for associate members, fifty cents; and for institutional members, two dollars.

Based upon the budget for 1970-71, tentatively approved by your 1970-71 Board, and on the assumption that a cimilar budgat might be adopted for subsequent years, your present Board suggests that the above might be changed to read:

Section 4. Annual dues Annual dues for regular members shall be four dollars; for associate members, two dollars; and for institutional members, ten dollars.

Following is the budget on which we based our figures. Wherever the amount of increase for any one committee is considerably increased, a justification statement prepared by the chairman of that committee is included. According to last year's diractory, we have 224 members.

In addition to the funds needed to finance the activities of the various committees, there are a number of activities that the organization could engage in if the Association wished: increased publications and similar services for members, more assistance for our own members in attending meetings, greater participation on a national level in the AASL, including possibly sending the HASL president to the annual convention. There are, I am sura, numbrous activities each of you could suggest.

Please consider the proposed amendment carefully before coming to the meeting on Oct. 10th so that you will be able to participate in the discussion and give us the benefit of your opinions.

We are planning a most exciting program and are looking forward to seeing you.


