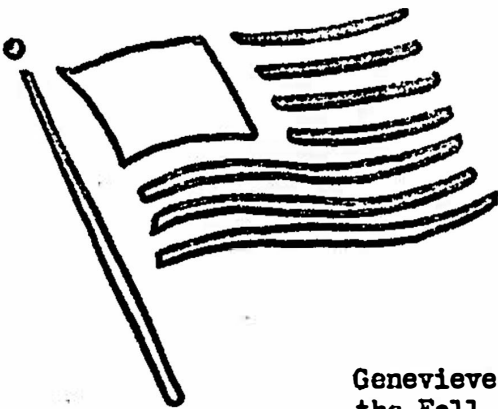

" . . . Successfully meeting the challenge of designing a 10,500 square foot school library to build for \$250,000 won an award for Herbert Y. Matsumura & Associates Inc.

The library, at the August Ahrens Elementary School in Waipahu is to handle the growing enrollment of Kindergarten through sixth grade pupils.

The site was a limited area in the existing campus and it was necessary to relate the design to surrounding space and buildings.

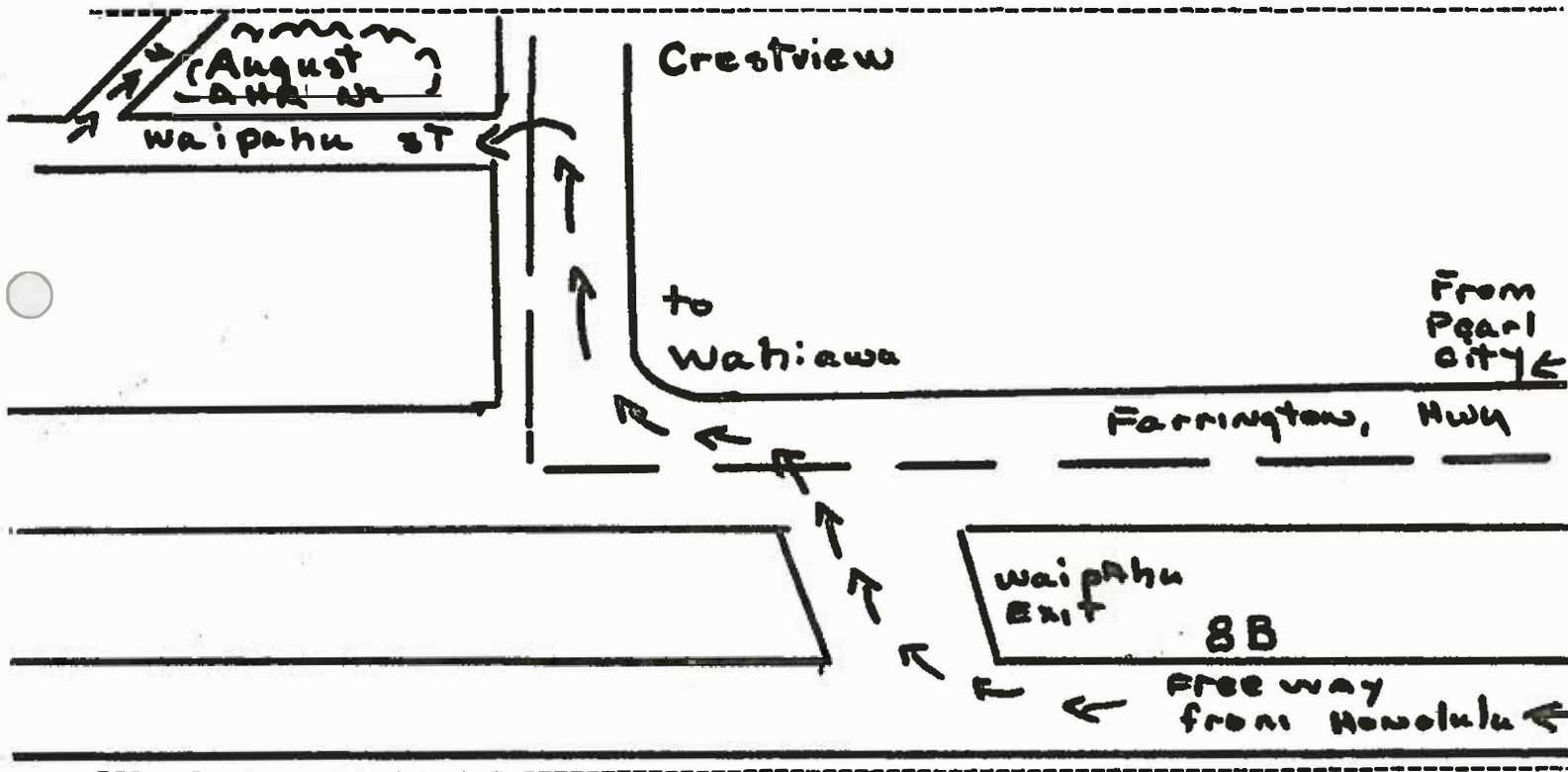
Oriented inward to the site, the library is the focal point of the school campus, centrally located in relation to the master plan for development of the school.

An outdoor reading court is directly outside the library, along the main thoroughfare of the campus.
